## Henry Myerberg

Principal, Rockwell Group, Design Director LIBRARY Initiative

KEYNOTE: October 10, 2006

Henry Myerberg, AIA, is a Principal with Rockwell Group, which he joined in February 2003. He received a Master of Architecture degree from Harvard University Graduate School of Design in 1980. Since launching his own firm in 1986, Henry has built a distinguished career in designing “artfully formed habitable stories” for houses, libraries, schools, stores, offices and galleries. His extensively published projects have won numerous awards including the 2001 national award from the American Institute of Architects and the American Library Association for the Rhys Carpenter Library, completed in 1997 at Bryn Mawr College. He is a frequent speaker and panelist at national conferences on library and educational topics.

Since 1999 Henry has been the volunteer design director for the LIBRARY initiative, led by the Robin Hood Foundation to reinvent libraries for New York City’s 650 public elementary schools. As co-head of one of the four design studios at Rockwell, Henry’s completed projects include several NYC public libraries, the re-branding of the Meijer stores, the Albany Public Library and Gap’s newest retail brand, Forth and Towne. Projects on-the-boards include the DeVos Children’s Hospital in Grand Rapids and SteelStax, performing arts complex in Bethlehem, PA.
